## **HISTORICAL SKETCH**

### **THE BEGINNING :**

The Akkineni Nageswara Rao College is the result of munificence and zeal for higher education of the people of Gudivada Taluk and of the neighbouring taluks in Krishna District. Situated in a rich agricultural area midway between Vijayawada and Machilipatnam and connected by road, rail with the leading towns and villages in the district. Gudivada has always been a centre of great cultural and political activity and its citizens have played a prominent part in the life of the nation in general and in particular of Andhra Pradesh. In the education sphere too, a seat of higher learning was felt, and to meet this need a strong Committee of local leaders was formed early in 1950, and an appeal for funds was made by Sri Parvataneni Venkataratnam (President), Sri Uppalapati Veerabhadra Rao (Treasurer), Sri Kaza Venkataramaiah (Secretary), Sri Vemulapalli Ramabrahmam (Joint Secretary), Sarva Sri Vadde Sobhanadri, Lingam Venkata Krishnaiah and Upadrashta Papanna Sastri as members.

### **INAUGURATION OF COLLEGE**

The College Organising Committee approached the authorities of the Andhra University in April, 1950 for permission to organize the institution and have it affiliated to the University. The Inspection Commission appointed by the University visited Gudivada in May 1950 and recommended affiliation. The College was formally inaugurated under the name "The Gudivada College" by Prof. V.S. Krishna, B.A. (Oxon), Ph-D (Vienna), Vice Chancellor of the University, on July 6, 1950 at a public meeting presided by Hon'ble Sri B. Gopala Reddy, Finance Minister, Government of Madras. The Secretary of the Organising Committee, Sri Kaza Venkataramaiah became the Correspondent of the College. Sri A.F. Thyagaraju was appointed as the first principal of the College.

### **ACADEMIC COURSES AND INFRASTRUCTURE :**

In July 1951, the Biology, Physics and Chemistry group was opened and 94 students were admitted. In July 1952 the college was raised to First Grade and B.A. and B.Com. classes were opened. The year 1953 saw further progress. B.Sc. class with Zoology (Main) and Chemistry and Botany Subsidiaries was opened. Civics and Indian Administration were offered as optional subjects in Intermediate Course, and in Arts groups classes were opened in Sanskrit for Intermediate and in Hindi for B.A. In July 1957, the Pre-University course was started with eight combinations of optional subjects. In July 1958 the Three Year Degree Courses were started in the College, thus making our institution conform to the national pattern of the college at education.

A highlight of 1958 was formation of the college play ground at the new site which is the beginning of a new era in the history of the college. It is in the fitness of things to mention here that as much as fifteen acres of land was donated by the philanthropic villagers of Pedaparupudi and Bhushanagulla.

Additional land was purchased with donations of Rupees 60,000/- and 40,000/- by Pedaparupudi and Bhushanagulla farmers respectively.

As if to join the spree of donations, there were a few donations by understanding individuals such as 3 acres of land by Smt. Mandava Rama Tulasamma, 1.12 acres by Sri Kolli Bhadraiah and 0.5 acres by Sri Vellanki Akkaiah Chowdary.

In February 1959, the next step forward was taken. The foundation stone for the new building was laid by Dr. V.S. Krishna, the then Vice-Chancellor. Work of the Construction began at once and the eastern wing of the ground floor came into being, a bare necessity for the Office of Principal, Laboratories and Library. Side by side with this, a spacious auditorium was also constructed named after Sri Yerneni Challamaiah, who donated about Rs. 60,000/-.

Since Sri Akkineni Nageswara Rao gave a donation of one Lakh rupees, the College was named after him from April 1959. Dr. Y. Venkateswara Rao, M.Sc., Ph.D., who succeeded Sri A.F. Thyagaraju could secure the active and willing co-operation of three popular doctors, Dr. A.V. Raghavaiah, Dr. T.L. Perumallu and Dr. P.L. Narasimha Rao for the completion of the remaining part of the building. Their hectic activity culminated in the collection of fairly handsome donations (about one lakh seventy five thousand rupees) from philanthropic public of Gudivada and neighbouring villages. To this was added, as promised, a sum of about rupees one lakh by Sri Akkineni Nageswara Rao and together with Govt. grants, the amount was utilised for the construction of the Western Wing of the Ground Floor and the First Floor of both eastern and western side of the main building. Teaching work had commenced in cement concrete rooms which is an achievement of our dream.

The next phase was our library. This was constructed on modern lines with maximum facilities for each category of the college population., students and staff. We are proud of our Library.

In accordance with a new pattern of education, the college started the new two year intermediate course from the academic year 1969-70.

A new pattern of degree course (called New Scheme) with Main and Ancillaries was started with effect from the academic year 1971-72 with Telugu as the medium of instruction.

Another notable achievement is the starting of M.Com. Course in 1974 - 75 thereby becoming one of the handful of affiliated colleges in Andhra to have the privilege of offering instruction at the post graduate level.

The construction work went on uninterrupted and by 1975 gymnasium also was built, and has since been used by students and staff with great enthusiasm. Consequent of donation of twenty five thousand rupees, the gymnasium was named after Sri Kolli Lingaiah.

The notable structure that was constructed in 1976 is Yerneni Govindaiah Junior College Building funded (Rupees one lakh) by his son Sri Rama Chandra Rao for this purpose. It was completed by 1984 and has been used since 1985. The foundation stone for the post graduate wing was laid in 1985 and the construction of the building was completed in 1992.

The postgraduate department was shifted to the newly constructed wing during 1992-93. Foundation stone was laid for Post-graduate block on 22-8-94 by the then chairman of University Grants Commission, Prof. G. Rami Reddy. The construction of men's hostel was completed in 1996 with the assistance of UGC as a part of VIII Plan Developmental Projects.

The history of the College should place on record, the demise of Sri Parvathaneni Venkataratnam, Founder President. Sri Kaza Venkataramaiah, Founder Secretary and Sri Yerneni Venkateswara Rao, Vice President of the committee during 1975 and 1976 who were responsible for building up the college as we are today.

Sri Upplapati Veerabhadra Rao, the founder member of the College Management Committee, who served the college for over half century, passed away on 22nd August 2005 at the age of 87. He served the college in many capacities-Treasurer, Secretary & Correspondent and President. The College places on record his yeoman service.

The College celebrated its silver jubilee in 1975-76, Sri J. Vengala Rao, the then Chief Minister inaugurated the celebrations, which was attended by several distinguished people.

Keeping the evergrowing importance of Computer Sciences and in response to the public demand for these subjects the college started three new restructured B.Sc., Courses, with Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics and Statistics Combinations.

Expansion of academic facilities was the order of the day and in keeping with this trend the College got permission and started the M.B.A. Course in the academic year 1993-94, which was inaugurated by Sri Y. C. Simhadri, the then Vice-Chancellor, Nagarjuna University on 7-2-1994. The M.Sc., in Mathematics was started in the academic year 1994 - 95.

The M.C.A., M.Sc. (Computer Science), B.C.A. and a new stream in B.Sc., Course with Mathematics, Statistics and Computers were started during the academic year 1998 - 99.

B.Ed Course was started during the academic year 1999-2000 under the aegis of ANR College of Education and D.Ed. course under ANR D.Ed. College in 2007.

A Post-Graduate Course, M.Sc., (IS) was started from the academic year 2001-2002, M.Sc. (Chemistry) from the Academic Year 2002-2003, a new Post-Graduate Course in M.Sc., (Physics) and a new Degree Course in B.Sc., (M.P.C.) from the Academic year 2003-04. Two more P.G. Courses i.e., M.Sc., (Botany) and M.Sc., (Micro-Biology) were commenced from the Academic year 2005-2006. The annual intake of MCA and MBA is extended from 60 to 120 from the Academic year 2007-08 and 2008-09 respectively. B.Com (Re-structured Course) commenced from Academic Year 2012-13.

Sri K.R.K. Prasad, Former Principal, V.S.M. College, Ramachandrapuram was appointed as Advisor, Academic & Administrative Affairs of the College with effect from 1-2-1998.

Prof. D.V. Suresh Kumar, Former President, faculty of Management Sciences & Commerce and Member of Syndicate, University of Madras was appointed as Director for P.G. & U.G. Un-aided courses with effect from 1-7-1999 and Prof. V. Narasimha Rao, working as Head of the MBA Department of this college since 1994 took charge as Director on 09-08-2006.

Sri M. Rama Mohana Rao was appointed as principal of K.G.P.R.A.N.R. College of Education with effect from 28-1-2000 and succeeded by Sri C.V. Chinulu who took charge as Principal w. e. f. 7-12-2001. Smt. Aruna Kumari took charge as principal w.e.f. 29-03-2008 and succeeded by Dr. J. Shakeela w.e.f.10-10-2012. Dr. S. Sankar took charge as principal of the College w. e. f. 31-12-2012. Sri K.P. Appaiah Chowdary appointed as Co-ordinator for KGPR-ANR College of Education and ANR D.Ed. Colleges w.e.f. 12-09-2012.

In the academic year 1998-99, a spacious laboratory with 75 Pentium computers was commissioned for M.C.A. During 1999-2000 another lab was opened with 45 latest Computers for B.Sc., (Maths, Statistics / Physics and Computer Sciences). This laboratory was named after Dr. Yarlagadda Lakshmi Prasad Computer Centre since it was financed by his M.P. "LADS" (Local Area Development Scheme) Funds. Computer with Internet facility and printer has also provided to the staff rooms of all individual departments of the college.

A hostel for women in the name of "Akkineni Annapoornamma Women's Hostel" was also constructed during 2003-04.

A fully furnished Internet facility was established for the benefit of students as well as staff members to equip themselves with the latest knowledge and developments taking through the world.

A 400 M running track(width 9.76m) was laid during 2005-06 at a cost of Rs. 3 Lakhs, which was sanctioned by U.G.C. Under X Plan. The Ministry of Youth Affairs and sports granted Rs. 3 Lakhs and it was utilised by the college to equip the gymnasium with Multi-Gym with 12 stations, Joggers (manual and electronic), Exercise cycles, Electronic Treadmill, Twisters, Vibrators and Weight Lifting set.

### **Golden Jubilee Celebrations**

The completion of 50 years called for Golden Jubilee Celebrations in which all those connected with the college participated. The committee members, the faculty, the office staff, students and alumni as well as the public took part enthusiastically during the three hectic days of celebrations on 21, 22 and 23 December 2000.

The then Chief Minister Sri Nara Chandra Babu Naidu inaugurated the celebrations. Many other V.I.P's including Sri M. Venkaiah Naidu, Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development and Her Excellency Smt. V.S. Ramadevi, Governor of Karnataka were kind enough to grace the occasion and offer their good wishes.

The festivities of the Jubilee were crowned by the exciting announcement of handsome donations, Rs. 10 lakhs by the presstycoon Sri Ramoji Rao, and old student of this college, in honour of his parents Cherukuri Venkata Subbaiah and Venkata Subbamma, Rs. 15 Lakhs by Dr. Y. Lakshmi Prasad from his M.P. LADS funds, Rs. 5 Lakhs by Sri Rajendra Prasad, Rs. 5 Lakhs by Sri Punukollu Badrachalam Trust, Rs. 1 Lakh by J.V. Satyanarayana, Rs. 10 Lakhs by Smt. K. Karuna Devi and her sons towards A.N.R. College of Education Building Fund and Rs. 10 Lakhs by the other members of "A.N.R. College Old Students" Association (ANR COSA) towards the construction of Golden Jubilee Commemoration Building which was inaugurated by Prof. L. Venugopal Reddy, Vice-Chancellor, Nagarjuna University on 17th August, 2002.

A Research center, under the purview of Acharya Nagarjuna University was established in the college in the year 2006 for the pursuers of M.Phil. and Ph. D. programmes. The P.G. Department of Business Administration is also a recognised Research Centre of Krishna University.

ANR College has secured FIRST PRIZE by being adjudged as "Best Performing Pro-fessional P.G.College (University Exam Results)" by Acharya Nagarjuna University and issued Certificate of Merit in its 32nd Foundation Day Celebrations on 11-9-2008.

The College was Re-accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC in September 2016.

The University Grants Commission has granted Autonomous Status to the College for a period of ten years w.e.f. 2018-19 to 2027-28.

The College is converted from Aided institution to Private institution from 09-09-2021 as per the orders of the Government.

In spite of the changing policies of successive governments in funding and recruitment, the College stands committed to its motto of serving the cause of education in the agrarian landscape.

## **Academic Rules and Regulations**

### **1. Academic Plan :**

These rules and regulations are applicable to the students from the Academic Year 2023-2024.

**1.1** The college follows the semester system with partial internal and partial external evaluation and choice based credit system for the under graduate and post graduate programmes.

**1.2** The academic year is divided into two semesters, each semester shall normally consist of minimum 90 instructional days. There shall be a minimum of 30 hours and maximum of 36 hours of teaching per week excluding the assessment hours.

**1.3** The instructional methods include conventional lectures, IT based sessions, class room interactions, guest lectures, seminars, symposia, field study, etc. The syllabi and the model question papers will be provided by the respective department board of studies.

#### **1.4 Board of Studies**

i. The Board of Studies shall prepare the Syllabi, the scheme of instruction and the scheme of evaluation and recommend them to the academic council for consideration and approval.

ii. The Board of Studies may recommend changes in the subjects of study and / or alter the syllabi prescribed for a course for consideration and approval of the academic council.

iii. The Board of Studies shall prepare panels of paper setters / Examiners paper-wise and such panels are to be submitted to the chairperson of the academic council.

**1.5** Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) offers wide ranging choice for students to opt for Programmes based on their aptitude and their career goals.

CBCS works on the fundamental premise that students are mature individuals, capable of making their own decisions. CBCS enables a student to obtain a degree by accumulating required number of credits prescribed for that degree. The number of credits earned by the student reflects the knowledge or skills acquired by him or her. Each course is assigned a fixed number of credits based on the contents to be learned & the expected effort of the student. The grade points earned for each course reflects the student's proficiency in that course.

- b) Learn at your own pace
- c) Continuous learning and student centric concurrent evaluation
- d) Active student-teacher participation
- e) Industry institute collaboration
- f) Interdisciplinary curriculum
- g) Employability enhancement

### **2. Programmes offered :**

#### **UG (Honours) Programmes with single major and minors**

The College presently offers coaching in the following UG programmes as per the Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programs, December 2022 of University Grants Commission.

This 4-year bachelor's degree program introduces holistic and multidisciplinary undergraduate education to provide the opportunity to focus on the chosen major and minors as per the choices of the student.

## 3. Admission Procedure :

### 3.1 UG Programmes

3.1.1 The notification for issue and receipt of applications for admission through online into U.G Programmes shall be notified by the Government in the web portal and in the news papers. Applications shall be submitted through online in the portal provided by the Government.

3.1.2 Admissions are made on the basis of merit at the qualifying examination and following the rules of reservation as prescribed by the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh from time to time.

3.1.3 The 'Admissions Committee' Constituted by the Principal for the purpose shall make the admissions for UG programmes.

### 3.2 PG Programmes

3.2.1 Students are admitted into M.B.A & M.C.A. programmes through ICET (Integrated Common Entrance Test) Exam conducted by Govt. of A.P. and as per guidelines given by APSCH from time to time.

3.2.2 Students are admitted into M.Com, M.Sc. Mathematics, M.Sc. Physics, M.Sc. Chemistry, M.Sc. Computer Science & M.Sc. Statistics Programmes through PG CET (All Universities Common Entrance Test) conducted by Government of Andhra Pradesh.

### 3.4 Regulations Governing Fee Payment :

3.4.1 The fee must be paid within the stipulated date as notified.

3.4.2 Fine will be levied for delayed payment.

3.4.3 The names of the defaulting students will be struck off the rolls thereafter.

3.4.4 The students are eligible for fee concession / scholarships according to Government provisions to the students of scheduled caste, scheduled tribes, listed backward classes, minorities and economically poor communities subject to their submission of necessary application forms along with required enclosures in time to the college office.

Students, who fail to submit the same, will have to pay all fees to the college. The balance of the fee not reimbursed by the Government will be collected from the students.

3.4.5. Transfer Certificate will be issued only after clearing all the dues to the college.

### 3.5 Schedule of Fee structure

### 3.5.2 Fee Structure: UGC - NSQF Certificate Course

An amount of Rs. 5,000/- will be collected from the students as per UGC - NSQF regulations.

### 3.6 Readmission /Transfer admission

3.6.1 A candidate, who is detained or discontinued a semester for whatever reason, for readmission into the same semester in the subsequent year, shall be required to pass in all the papers in the curriculum prescribed for such batch of students in which he/she joins subsequently so as to be eligible for the award of degree. However, exemption will be given from passing all those papers of the subsequent semesters, (of the batch which he/she joins now) which he/she had passed in the earlier semester he/she was originally admitted into. Further, such a candidate shall be required to pass the new papers, if any, introduced in the new curriculum.

3.6.2 Candidates may be admitted into II-VI semesters on transfer based on the recommendation of the committee constituted by the Principal for the purpose and such admissions are subject to the approval of Krishna University.

Such candidates shall be required to pass in all the Programmes in the programme prescribed for such batch of students, he/she joins to be eligible for the award of degree. However, exemption will be given in all those Programmes of the semester/s of the batch, which he/she joins now, which he / she had passed earlier.

### 4. Conduct – Rules and Regulations

4.1 This college is a temple of learning. You come to us with the noble objective - "ENTER TO LEARN AND LEAVE TO SERVE".

4.2 Do not loiter on the campus. If you have leisure, spend the time usefully in the library and reading room. Group gatherings and loud amusing chats and roaming aimlessly before classrooms are strictly prohibited.

4.3 Maintain absolute silence in the library and reading room. You should not disturb fellow-students who are in deep study.

4.4 Maintain decency and decorum in your classroom, library, laboratories and on the campus in general.

4.5 Every student will be provided with an identity card which he/she must keep as long as he/she is a student of this college. Whenever he/she approaches the office/departments on academic or administrative matters, he/she must produce his/her Identity Card. Along with the hall ticket the Identity Card should also be produced for appearing semester-end examination (theory or practical). ID card must be worn around the neck.

4.6 No student shall leave the class room without the permission of the lecturer.

4.7 Calling students out of their class rooms while the lecture is in progress is prohibited.

4.8 Some student's behaviour is covert (sleeping, late arrival to class etc.) while others are more apparent and overt (talking during class etc.) in the class. However both behaviours attract punishment by the lecturer.

4.9 For smooth and peaceful academic environment, riding any vehicle in the college premises is prohibited. Also vehicles must be parked in the specified places.

- 4.10 Keep your surroundings clean and tidy. Remember the saying: Cleanliness is next to Godliness.
- 4.11 Smoking, Drinking, Gutka chewing in the college premises is strictly prohibited.
- 4.12 Going on strike or involving in any serious indiscipline shall make students or liable to disciplinary action.
- 4.13 Forming student unions and associations in any aspect of creed, caste, language, religion or ideology are not permissible.
- 4.14 Students are not allowed to conduct meetings / gatherings for any reason in the campus without prior permission from the Principal / Director.
- 4.15 The responsibility of infrastructure maintenance lies on each and every student. Any loss or damage caused due to carelessness or negligence on the part of the student shall be recovered from the student.
- 4.16 Students should not raise funds either for charity or any other purpose. Collecting money from students or outsiders without the permission of the Principal / Director is prohibited.
- 4.17 Use of Cell phones and cameras are strictly prohibited in all academic areas of the campus. If any student is found using them, the gadget will be confiscated.
- 4.18 Organizing pleasure trips, picnics etc. by students without prior permission from the Principal is strictly prohibited.
- 4.19 Ragging is a criminal offence and the UGC has framed Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009, in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging in Indian Universities/Colleges/ Institutions. In case of any complaint, students can approach the members of the Anti-ragging committee or the Vice-Principal or the Principal.
- 4.20 We offer information required by the Public as per the Right to information Act, 2005.

- 4.21 The exhibition of Citizens' Charter is for the benefit of the Parents and the Students.
- 4.22 Mentoring system :
- Every staff member will be in-charge of 20 students for mentoring. Student profile book is maintained in the college, which consists of necessary information related to the student concerned. Each mentor will officially interact with the student at least twice in a semester. Besides this, the student is encouraged to meet the lecturer concerned by taking an appointment with him/her suggestions that pave a way for his all round development.
- 4.23 Laboratories
- a) Science students should attend their practical class regularly since experiments will not be repeated for the sake of absentees.
- b) Students should note down all relevant points in observation books and submit their record books punctually. Since the records carry marks, they should be maintained neatly and accurately.
- c) Students should not leave the laboratory without returning the apparatus lent to them.
- d) Students should handle the apparatus carefully as they have to pay full cost of apparatus they break or spoil even inadvertently. Consumable materials like chemicals should be used sparingly as they are costly.
- 4.24 Library and Reading room :
- i. The Library is open from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on all working days. The issue counter will be closed at 5 p.m.
- ii. Others who wish to become members may be admitted on application to the Principal, recommended by a teacher who shall stand surety. They will be required to make a deposit of Rs. 150/- and to pay a Library Fee of Rs. 150/- per year on admission towards membership of the library. If they wish to join the reading room only they need not pay the deposit.

- iii. No non-member shall be admitted into the library except when he is introduced by a member, but such admission does not confer the privilege of making use of the library for reference purposes. Students are not permitted to introduce non - members to the library.
- iv. Current periodicals may be read only in the place set apart for the purpose.
- v. All books must be applied for and returned in person. No books will be issued to messengers.
- vi. Absence from the college will not relieve a borrower of the responsibility of returning the books on the due date.
- vii. Members entering or leaving the library should pass all books including note books through the entrance/exit counter.
- viii. Member shall be allowed books as follows :

Members of the Teaching Staff and Committee	15 to 30 Vols.
Members of the college Clerical Staff	10 to 15 Vols.
Students	2 to 5 Vols.
Attenders	5 Vol.
Other Members granted permission	3 Vols.
- ix. Borrowers are eligible to keep a book for 14 days from the date of issue. At the end of the period the books shall be returned to the library, but may be reissued to the same person if it is not in the meantime applied for by someone else. When the book is thus reissued to a person, he may retain it for a further period of one week. Two renewals may be allowed without the presentation of the book at the counter.
- x. The Librarian may recall a book at any time during the period of its loan.
- xi. Reference books should not be taken out of the library. They may however, be issued to members of the teaching staff for class use; and books thus taken out should be returned before 4-00 pm on the same day. The issued book will be noted in a special register maintained for this purpose.

- xii. Borrowers failing to return books or periodicals on or before the day last noted in the date label of the book or periodical should pay a penalty of Rs. 1/- per book or periodical for each day. In the calculation of fines, the day on which the library is not working will not be counted.
- xiii. When a book is received from the library, it should be examined carefully and the attention of the librarian should be drawn to the defects therein. Otherwise the last borrower will be held responsible for the defects. Every reader borrowing a book shall be responsible for the defects. Every reader borrowing a book shall be responsible for its custody until it is returned. In the event of any loss or damage to the books, he / she shall replace the book at his / her own cost or pay such compensation as may be fixed by the Principal in consultation with the Librarian.
- xiv. If a volume belonging to a set is lost, the reader may be required to replace the whole set.
- xv. Borrowers are not permitted to lend books borrowed from the library to others.
- xvi. Books, periodicals, Maps etc, should not be marked, written upon or damaged. No tracing is allowed without the permission of the librarian. Cutting or mutilating of books, periodicals or other property of the library is strictly forbidden and will entail penalties which may include suspension of the privilege of membership.

#### 4.25 Text book library

- i. A Text Book Library has been instituted in the college with financial assistance of U.G.C. The purpose of the library is to lend standard text books to students who cannot afford to purchase them. The following are the rules of the text book library.
- ii. A student who wants to borrow a book should pay 10% of the cost of the book towards maintenance of book. He can retain the book till the last working day of the academic year.

iii. No underlining, making comment, etc., should be made anywhere in the book, nor any part of the book torn off. A fine of Rs. 5/- or more will be collected for such markings, underlining etc.

iv. The librarian reserves the right to call for its return at any time.

v. If the book is lost or damaged, its present market cost will be recovered in full from the student with a fine of Rs. 5/- towards servicing charges.

vi. Books from the Text Book Library will be issued to the Students as per the following rules :

a) Books will be issued to students belonging to S.C., S.T. and other Economically Backward Classes.

b) If after such issue, books are still available, they will be issued to students belonging to other castes/classes.

c) These books should be returned on or before the last working day.

4.26 Physical Education Department activities under Autonomous System as detailed below :

a) Conducting the games and sports committee meetings and taking approval to the year plan and budget.

b) Providing the sports equipment to the students within the budget.

c) Encouraging the students to utilize the indoor and outdoor sports facilities for Athletics, Badminton, Basket ball, Chess, Cricket, Foot ball, Gym, Kabadi, Kho-Kho, Table tennis, Volley ball etc., which are available in the college

d) Conducting the selection trials and coaching camps in the morning and evening sessions to participate in the intercollegiate/District/State meets.

e) Providing diet and kit allowances to the selected players who represent the college in the external competitions.

f) Payment of incentives to the inter University/State Level participants.

g) Organization of the intercollegiate tournaments in the college.

h) Conducting the intramural games and sports to the students annually and awarding prizes to the winners.

4.27 Hostel Regulations :

a) All movements from and to the hostels should be recorded in the movement register kept with the security guard at the entrance of the hostel and should be properly signed.

b) The attendance timings are 6 A.M in the morning 7 P.M in the evening.

c) Perfect silence is to be maintained in the hostel premises.

d) If any hosteller is found indulging in any form of instigation/intimidation/threat to any other hostellers he/she will be asked to vacate the hostel forthwith. In this regard, the decision of the Chief Warden is final and binding on the individual's concerned.

#### 5. Attendance :

5.1 A minimum attendance of 75% in theory and completion of 90% of the practical prescribed for the course is necessary for a student to qualify to attend the Semester-End Examination of UG & PG programmes.

5.2 The Principal is authorized to condone the shortage of attendance in theory papers in deserving cases on recommendation of the Head of the Department, by collecting prescribed fee. However, the student should have to put in a minimum attendance of 60% in aggregate of the total number of instructional days in theory classes. However, a student shall be eligible to claim for condonation of attendance shortage twice during the course work.

5.3 The student who has not satisfied the above rule will be detained and will not be allowed to take semester end examinations. Such student will have to repeat the semester in the subsequent academic year. The marks scored in Continuous Internal Assessment will be forfeited and not carried forward.

5.4 The student who is continuously absent for more than 20 working instructional days without any prior permission or leave on special grounds will not be permitted to attend the classes and the names of such students will be struck off from rolls without any notice. In such cases, students will be permitted into classes on readmission basis at the discretion of the Principal.



5.5 In case, a student represents college, at intercollegiate or interuniversity or state or national level tournaments/athletics, approved N.C.C. and N.S.S. camps, the actual number of days, (excluding Sundays and holidays) the student is engaged in such activities, shall be added to his/her class attendance, subject to a maximum of 20 days in a year and further subject to maximum of 15 days in a semester.

However, special consideration may be given to candidates participating in national events. Prior permission of the Principal is required to avail this, as recommended by the Games Committee, NCC & NSS Committee.

5.6 Allotment of marks in Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) for the attendance :

<75%	= 0 Marks
75% to < 80%	= 3 Marks
80% to < 90%	= 4 Marks
90% or above	= 5 Marks

5.7 A candidate who is detained in a semester due to lack of attendance has to obtain written permission from the Principal for readmission into the same semester after duly fulfilling the required norms stipulated by the college and by paying the required tuition fee and special fee along with readmission fee. A student of I semester in the event of detention should seek fresh admission.

## 6. Course Credit Structure

### 6.1 Award of U.G. Programmes

A student will be declared eligible for the award of the Certificate / Diploma / Degree / Honours as per the academic guidelines appended as Annexure - I

### 6.2 Award of Degree in P.G. Programmes

A student will be declared eligible for the award of the PG Degree, if he/she pursues a course of study for not less than two academic years and not more than four academic years.

## 7. Evaluation of Academic Achievement :

### 7.1 Evaluation method: (CIA + SEE)

i. The academic performance of the student in theory and practical courses in a semester is evaluated by both internal and external examiners. The achievement in the theory and practical papers are evaluated between CIA and SEE as detailed below :

ii. CIA is done by the teacher / department concerned.

iii. The marks awarded in CIA and SEE are aggregated to arrive at the marks scored by the student in a paper.

iv. The evaluation of project work and the distribution of marks between CIA and SEE shall be as per the recommendations of respective Boards of Studies approved by Academic Council.

v. Achievement in a theory & Practical Paper is evaluated in the ratio 30:70 between Course Internal and Course External for UGC-NSQF Certificate Programmes. In Internship/Project Work the Pass Mark shall be 50% out of Maximum Mark 100.

ii. The marks scored by the student in the two tests are averaged and proportionately reduced to a maximum of 20 marks for UG and PG (If the final marks are in fraction, it shall be rounded off to the next number)

iii. Attendance marks are awarded scrupulously following the rule.5.6

iv. Marks for assignments / seminars are awarded based on the criteria to be spelt out by the Head of the Department and informed to the students in advance.

v. The blueprint for Internal examination question paper is followed as per the recommendations of the concerned Board of Studies.

vi. The question paper for internal assessment shall be submitted to the Controller of Examinations by the Head of the Department two days before the commencement of internal examinations.

vii. The marks for internal assessment will be awarded by the concerned lecturer and finalized by the Head of the Department and shall be submitted to the Controller of Examinations through Principal before commencement of semester end examinations.

viii. The valued answer scripts shall be verified and signed by the student.

ix. The bundles of valued answer scripts along with question paper and award list shall be handed over to Controller of Examinations within 10 days after completion of every mid-term examination.

x. The student may appeal the concerned Head of the Department within two days of declaring/notifying the marks if he/she is not satisfied with the marks awarded to him/her. The concerned Head of the Department in turn may consider the appeal and if required makes an arrangement to revalue the answer script and inform the final marks within 2 working days.

xi. Pass mark for internal assessment test including attendance performance is 40%.

xii. Re-mid exam shall be conducted to the students who failed in the internal exam along with absentees who seek prior permission from the Principal. The exam will be on the total syllabus of the subject. The student has to pay a fee of Rs.200/- Per subject

xiii. A candidate (UG & PG), who fails in re-mid examinations is required to get the minimum pass marks in that particular subject in mid examination any time during his/her course duration.

xiv. Internal Exam – Rules of Examination

a) Students should carry their identity card while entering into the examination hall.

b) Students are expected to be in their respective seats at the stroke of the First bell.

c) Students will not be allowed to take the internal assessment test after the expiry of 15 minutes from the commencement of the test. Further, they are not permitted to leave the examination hall within 90 minutes from the commencement of the test.

d) Students are expected to maintain silence in the examination hall.

e) Students are strictly prohibited from any sort of malpractice in the examination hall and the students resorted to malpractices are seriously viewed. They will be punished as per the recommendations of the Examination committee.

xv. There will be TWO Internal Examinations with 90 minutes duration for UGC- NSQF Certificate Programmes.

### 7. 2. 2 Practical :

#### i) UG Programmes :

- a) The Internal practical examination is conducted as per the recommendations of the concerned Board of Studies.
- b) The bundles of valued answer scripts along with question paper and award list shall be handed over to Controller of Examinations after completion of internal practical examination.

#### ii) PG Programmes / UGC - NSQF Certificate Programmes :

- a) Day- to- day work in the laboratory shall be evaluated for CIA Marks by the Concerned laboratory Teacher based on the Regularity/Record/Viva.
- b) Day-to-Day Evaluation sheet/Continuous evaluation of Practical sheet shall be handed over to the Controller of Examinations at the End of the Semester with Consolidated Marks Sheet.

### 7.3 Semester - End Examinations (SEE) :

Semester-End Examinations shall be conducted in theory and practical papers at the end of every semester.

#### 7. 3. 1 UG Programmes :

- i) The maximum mark in Languages Major and Minor courses shall be 70 with duration of 3 hours. The pass mark will be **40% or 28 marks out of 70 marks.**
- ii) The maximum mark in Multidisciplinary Courses, Skill Courses, Common Value-Added Courses shall be 50 with duration of 2 hours. The pass mark will be **40% or 20 marks out of 50 marks.**
- iii) The practical examination shall be conducted as per the recommendations of the concerned Board of Studies.
- iv) The student is declared to have passed in a theory / practical course if he/she secures at least 40% in semester-end examination and 40% in aggregate (i.e. marks in continuous internal assessment and marks in semester-end examination taken together) for all UG programmes.

- v) The blueprint for semester-end examination question paper is as per the recommendations of the concerned Board of Studies.

### 7. 3. 2 PG Programmes :

#### a) M.Sc. Programmes

- i. The maximum mark in each course shall be 70 with duration of 3 hours. The pass mark will be 40% or 28 marks out of 70 marks.
- ii. The student is declared to have passed in a theory course if he / she secures at least 40% in semester-end examination and 50% in aggregate (i.e. marks in continuous internal assessment and marks in semester-end examination taken both theory and practical together) for all PG programmes except M.Com. and 40% in aggregate for M.Com.
- iii. The student is declared to have passed in a practical course if he/she secures at least 50% in aggregate (i.e. marks in continuous internal assessment and marks in semester-end examination taken together) in Practical / Project work for all PG programmes.
- iv. The students of all PG Programmes shall have to secure minimum 50% marks in the viva-voce examination.

#### b) MBA / MCA Programmes

- i. The maximum mark in each course shall be 70 with duration of 3 hours. The pass mark will be **40% or 28 marks out of 70 marks.**
- ii. A candidate shall be eligible for the award of MBA /MCA degree if he/she secures the minimum academic requirements in a course (i.e. securing a minimum of 40% of marks in the SEE and a minimum aggregate of 50% of the total marks in the SEE and CIA taken together).
- iii. The student is declared to have passed in a practical course if he/she secures at least 50% in aggregate (i.e. marks in continuous internal assessment and marks in semester-end examination taken together) in Practical / Project work for all MBA / MCA programmes.
- iv. The students of all MBA / MCA Programmes shall have to secure minimum 50% marks in the viva-voce examination.

c) The blueprint for Internal examination question paper is followed as per the recommendations of the concerned Board of Studies.

### 7. 3. 3 Semester-end examinations - Rules of examination hall :

- i. Students should carry their hall ticket to the examination hall.
- ii. The duration of the exam shall be 3 hours. Students will not be allowed to take the examination after the expiry of half-an-hour from the commencement of the examination. Further, they are not permitted to leave the examination hall within two and half hours from the commencement of the examination. After two and half hours, a student may leave the examination hall, on surrendering the answer script. Students are allowed to attend calls of nature, only during last 1 1/2 hrs
- iii. Students are not permitted to bring pagers, cell phones, organizers etc., to the examination hall. However, they can use simple calculators.
- iv. Students are not permitted to exchange calculators, rulers, pencils, sharpeners, log tables or any such articles in the examination hall. Any sort of indiscipline in the examination hall will not be entertained.

### 7. 3. 4 PG Semester End Examination - Valuation

- i. Two valuations to be done for PG Semester End Examinations, out of which one valuation is to be done by a Lecturer having Ph.D./NET/SET/teaching the concerned subject with a minimum service of 3 academic years. If there are no eligible lecturers in the college / department, the valuation will be done by examiners from outside the college.
- ii. The average of marks obtained in valuation-I and valuation-II is taken for awarding grade to a student.
- iii. If there is a variation of 20% or more of maximum marks between I and II valuations, then the III valuation is to be taken up. (For a maximum marks of 70, if the variation is 14 marks or more between I & II valuations, then the III valuation is to be taken up.)
- iv. If a script is valued for a third time, the average of two nearest valuations will be awarded as final marks for awarding the grade.

v. Scrutiny of the scripts is to be done separately for each valuation.

### 7. 3. 5. UGC - NSQF Certificate Course :-

The Pass Mark is 40% for each theory paper and 50% for the Practical / Internship / Project work.

### 7. 3. 6. UGC - NSQF Certificate Programmes Evaluation :-

There will be single valuation and will be done by the External Examiner outside the College.

### 9. Revaluation in Semester-end examinations

The student may appeal to the Principal for revaluation / re-verification his/her answer scripts of theory papers, if the student is not satisfied with the marks awarded. Applications along with the revaluation fee receipt shall be submitted to the Principal within 6 working days from the date of announcement of marks/ declaration of results.

Revaluation shall be allowed only in theory courses and shall not be allowed for performance in lab practical courses, seminar course, project work / viva-voce and CIA.

Marks scored earlier or marks scored in revaluation, whichever is higher shall be the final marks and recorded.

**Note :** 50% of the revaluation fee shall be refunded to the candidate if he/she is benefitted and passed on revaluation to the extent of 10% of maximum marks.

### 10 Personal Verification of Answer Script :

After revaluation, a student from UG / PG Programme can also apply for personal verification of the answer script, which will be shown to the student in the presence of a subject expert from the college / department. A prescribed fee has to be paid for this purpose.

**Note :** 50% of the fee shall be refunded to the candidate if he/she is benefitted and passed on personal verification to the extent of 10% of maximum marks.

### 11.Reappearance for the failed candidates :

- A candidate, who fails in a paper in semester-end examinations, may appear for the examination in that paper with the subsequent batch of students for both UG and PG.
- The special examinations to UG Programmes for failed candidates having maximum of three theory subjects (Except Practical examinations) in a semester will be conducted after declaring the results of the respective semesters. The Re-internal examination will also be conducted for these candidates who have not obtained minimum marks in CIA. The class work goes on as usual during the special examinations.

### 12. Betterment :

A Candidate who passed in all the papers of a Semester can take betterment Examination in theory Programmes for improving his/her aggregate marks with immediately following batch of students during the term of programme.

### 13. Change of Syllabus / Course

- Where a course of programme is dropped from the curriculum and another Course is introduced, only three chances in succession are given.
- Where the syllabus in a course is revised, only three chances in succession shall be allowed in that course with pre-revised syllabus. Candidates, who do not pass in these three chances in succession, will have to take the new course with the revised syllabus/course for their subsequent attempts within six years (for three years programme), within five years (for two year programme) from the date of joining. However, the students request may be put forward by the Principal to the academic council to seek permission for extension by one year to the student to complete his/her study for a genuine reason.

#### 14. Repeat the Semester :

Any student of UG / PG programmes who fails to satisfy the rules regarding the attendance and who is detained or discontinued as per the rules prescribed by APSCE / University.

#### 15. Malpractices :

The suspected cases of malpractices in internal assessment and semester-end examination shall be referred to the Malpractices Enquiry Committee constituted by the Principal. The committee shall recommend the punishments as per the approved scales of punishment.

#### 16. General Matters :

- i. The Controller of Examinations shall arrange for the conduct of the Examinations by the Principal under his general supervision.
- ii. The Controller of Examinations shall maintain such stationery and records as are necessary for the conduct of examinations and for recording, storing and retrieving of the marks and other particulars relating to the examinations.
- iii. The Controller of Examinations shall make arrangements for the evaluation of the students' performance and submit the results to the principal, who in turn transmit them to the university for the award of degrees.
- iv. The Principal shall deal with any academic problem, which is not covered under these rules and regulations, in consultation with the Programmes Committee in an appropriate manner, and subsequently such actions shall be placed before the academic council for ratification. Any emergency modification of regulation, approved by the academic council earlier, shall be reported to the academic-council for ratification.
- v. "Grievance and Redressal Committee" (General) constituted by the Principal shall deal with all grievances pertaining to academic/administrative/disciplinary matters.
- vi. The Principal may advise the Academic Council for the inclusion or deletion of any rule/rules to these Rules and Regulations.
