Analysis of Student Feed Back On Curriculum

2022-2023

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Akkineni Nageswara Rao College, Gudivada has obtained **Feedback on Curriculum from 370 students** for the academic year 2022-2023.

They have give the feedback on the following Questionnaire.

1. The syllabus and sequence of courses in different semesters/years of the programme are accurate.
2. The programme and course out comes are well defined in Curriculum.
3. Lectures/Practical/Assignments help to understand the course contents are adequate.
4. Availability of the study material in the Departmental/Central Library
5. Sessional and End Semester exams are conducted well in time and with proper coverage of all units in the curriculum.
6. The programme Curriculum encompasses the skill, competence, employability, opportunities and entrepreneurship required to plan the career.
7. Student-centric methods i.e., Seminar/Workshop/field visits/group discussions/competence result into comprehensive learning.
8. The follow-ups of curriculum delivery outcomes are well in place.
9. The curriculum is effectively taught by teachers using ICT tools and online resource material.
10. Over all Rating of the Programme Curriculum.

Over all, what are the suggestions, that you would like to give for the improvement of the entire program.

Analysis

1. In response to the question about the syllabus and sequence of courses in different semesters of the programme are accurate, 56% responded as excellent, 37% stated as very good and remaining students responded as satisfactory.
2. In response to the question, programme and course outcomes are well defined in curriculum 85% students responded good and the remaining responded as satisfactory.
3. Regarding the question, Lectures, practicals, assignments help to understand the course content, Majority of the students are well satisfied and responded as good. Students are very happy with the lab facilities.
4. Regarding the question, Availability of the study material in the library 88% of the students responded good and 12% of the students responded satisfactory.
5. In response to the question on semester end exams and coverage of syllabus more number of students responded excellent.
6. In response to the question skill, competence and employability opportunities more number of students responded as good.
7. Regarding the seminars, workshops and comprehensive learning more than 86% of the students responded good.
8. In response to the question, follow-ups of curriculum delivery outcomes are well in place 84% of the students responded good.
9. In response to the ICT tools 55% of the students responded as excellent and 28% responded as good and remaining responded as satisfactory.

The majority of the students expressed satisfaction with the course material and the lab components assigned to them. Some students felt that self-learning courses are to be given priority in curriculum.

These suggestions were communicated to the Governing Body.

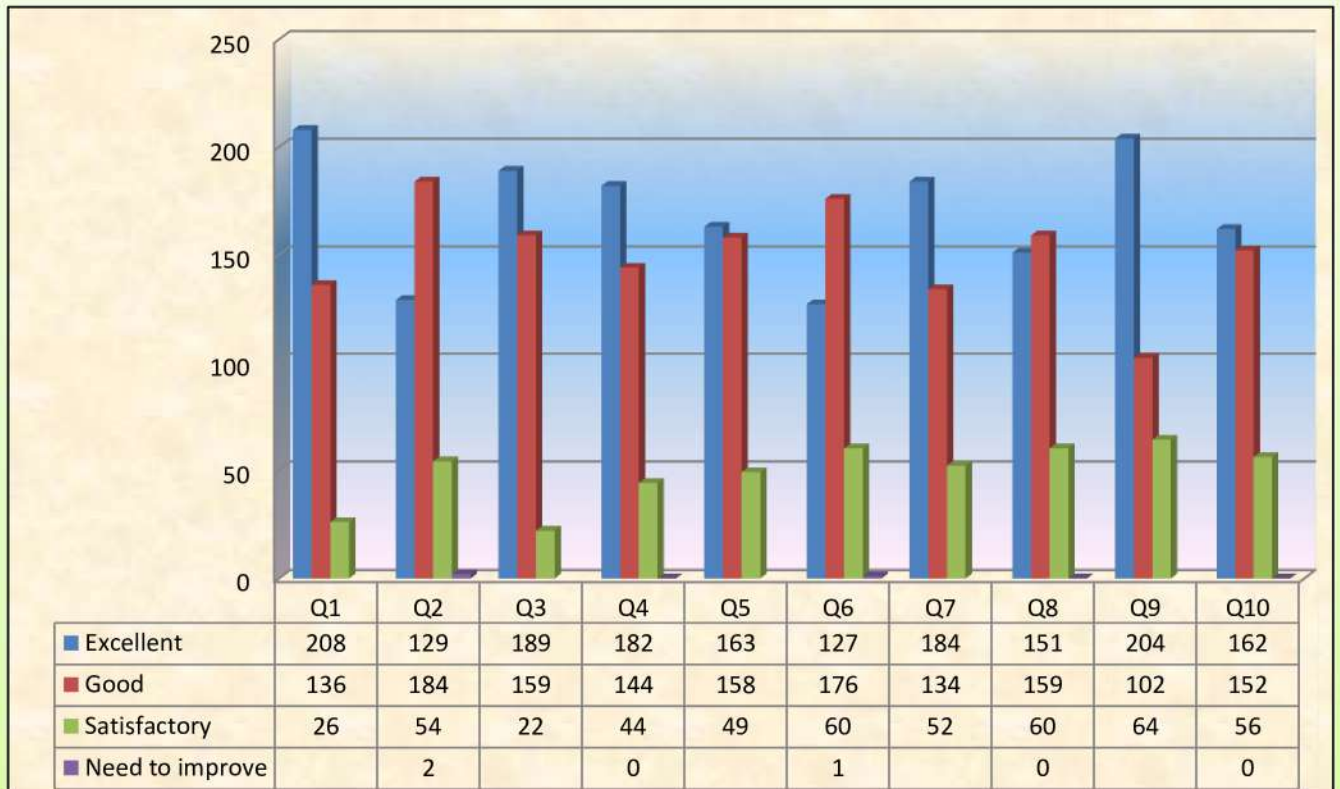

They have give the feedback on the following Questionnaire.

1. The syllabus is need based, updated and has good balance between theory and application.
2. The syllabus provides comprehensive knowledge and perspective in the subject area.
3. The assessment and evaluation system objectively measure the Course Outcomes (COs) and Program Outcomes (POs).
4. The college has enough relevant resources which are updated regularly for teaching learning purposes.
5. Course content has enough scope for development of analytical, logical, technical and creative skills to the students.
6. The syllabus has prospects for competitive exams/higher education/employability.

Analysis

1. In response to the question about syllabus is need based, updated and has good balance between theory and applications 83% of the faculty members are strongly agreed and 17% were agreed.
2. Regarding the question syllabus provides comprehensive knowledge and perspective in the subject area most of the faculty members are agreed.
3. In response to the question about assessment and evaluation system objectively measure the Course Outcomes (COs) and Program Outcomes (POs) majority members are strongly agreed with the present curriculum.
4. Majority faculty members are strongly agreed with the college has enough relevant resources which are updated regularly for teaching learning purposes.
5. In response to the question, Course content relating to the development of analytical, logical, technical and creative skills among the students 66% of the faculties strongly agreed and remaining are agreed.
6. Regarding the question, syllabus has prospects for competitive exams/higher education/employability majority 60% of the faculty members are strongly agreed and 40% members were agreed with the present curriculum.

In order to keep up with changing technology, the faculty believed that new UG and PG programs needed to be introduced. It is recommended that the infrastructure of the computer lab be expanded to allow students from all disciplines to use it for longer hours.

These suggestions were communicated to the Governing Body.

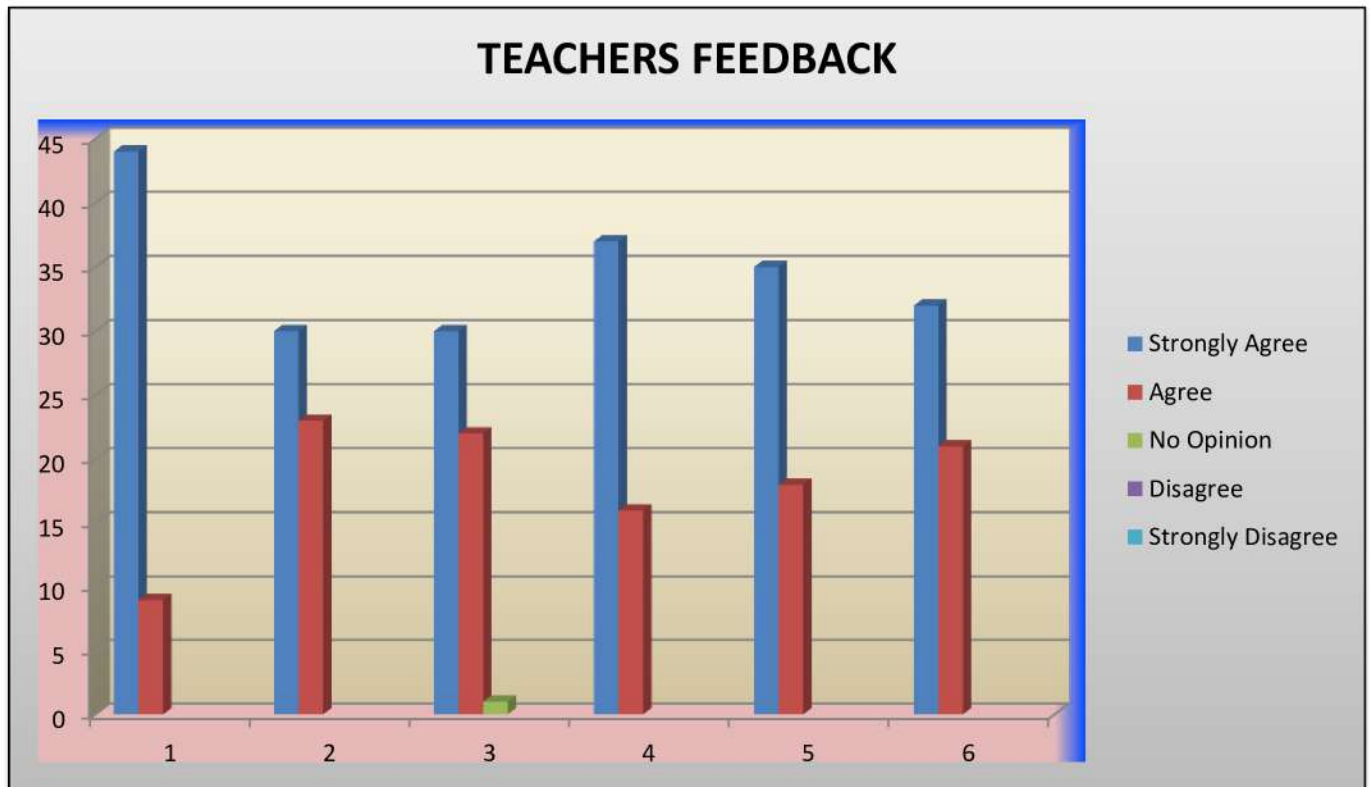

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2022-2023 ACADEMIC YEAR-TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

Analysis

1. In response to the question, 75% of the members are strongly agreed and 17% where agreed that Syllabus was sufficiently updated and generated more interest.
2. All the alumni obeyed that Course content helped to develop there analytical, logical, technical and creative skills.
3. Respond to the question more number of alumni agreed that the course curriculum was intellectually stimulate.
4. Around 97% of the alumni have good opinion on the books available in the library.
5. For 99% of the respondents, the syllabus has been helpful to achieve their current status.
6. In response to the question, the present syllabus generated interest in research for all of them.
7. For 98% of the alumni, the present curriculum helpful to achieve their goals.
8. New skilled based courses to be added to the curriculum to achieve the present society needs.

These suggestions were communicated to the Governing Body.

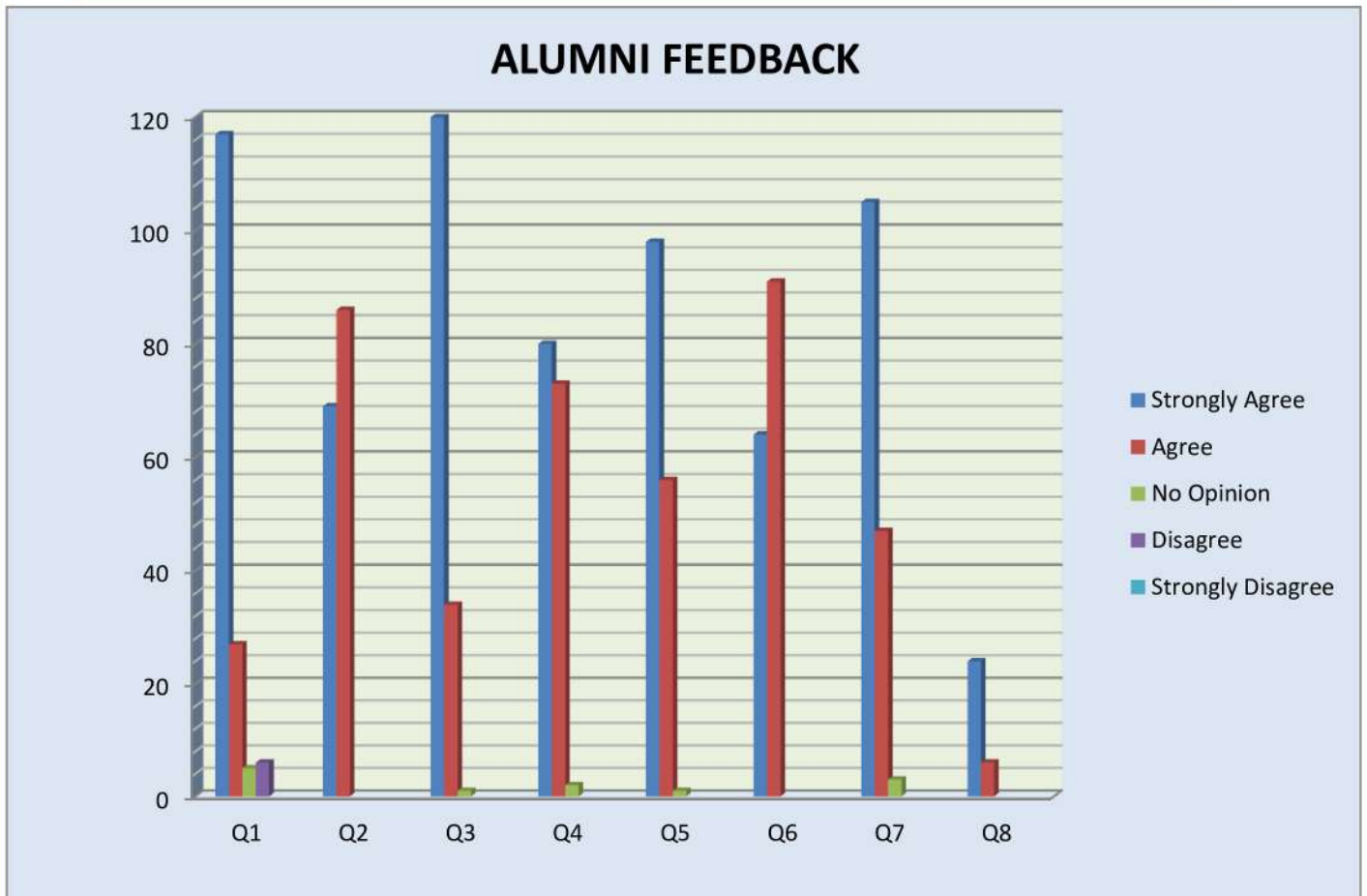



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2022-2023 ACADEMIC YEAR - ALUMNI FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM

6. Awareness on the recent developments in the field is provided.

Analysis

1. Most of the employers agreed (79%) for that the syllabus makes the student competent.
2. Around 64% of the employers Strongly agreed the fact that the syllabus promotes innovative thinking.
3. The syllabus is effective in developing the entrepreneurial skills of the students and is strongly agreed by most of the employers(68%).
