

9. In response to the ICT tools more number of students responded as good.




- 1. The syllabus is need based, updated and has good balance between theory and application.






They have give the feedback on the following Questionnaire.

- 9. Any other suggestions


#### Analysis


The feedback was collected from 130 Alumni and the observations are noted as follows

They have give the feedback on the following Questionnaire.


- 1. The Syllabus makes the Student Competent.

#### Analysis


- 1. Most of the employers agreed that the present mode of syllabus makes the student competent.

- 6. The syllabus provides awareness of the recent developments in the technological field from the perspective is agreed by the all employers.


