Assessment of Learning Levels Policy

Scope

This policy applies to all students enrolled in programs and courses at ANR College. It covers both internal assessments, which are used to provide feedback to students and improve teaching practices, and semester end examination, which are used to evaluate student learning outcomes.

Assessment Methods

Assessment methods may include but are not limited to: -Bridge Course

- Continuous Internal Assessment

- Semester End Examinations

-Paper-Presentations

- Internships/Projects

-Performance in co-curricular activities

These methods should be aligned with the learning outcomes of each program or course and should provide a comprehensive picture of student learning.

Frequency and Timing

Evaluations will be carried out periodically during the academic year, with particular timing established by individual faculty members and programme managers. Typically, the Semester End Examinations are held at the conclusion of each semester.

Reporting and Feedback

Assessment results will be promptly given to both students and mentors to offer them with feedback regarding the progress of the student. The assessment results will be utilised by faculty and mentors/ward counsellors to pinpoint areas in their teaching techniques that require improvement.
